



CUPE Air Canada Flight Attendants Strike / Lockout Update #1

Many members have reached out looking for information. Rest assured your Union has been in talks with the Company on contingency plans. As soon as there is something concrete to report, the information will be posted here. The Bargaining Committee will be releasing a statement tomorrow as well.

The only things I can report are:

- 1) the Company is not giving out RO (but will consider it day of) as they want “all hands on deck”.
- 2) Coinciding with the anticipated reduction in flying, many of the lines “Gate side” will be redeployed to other areas. This would include the MLL and CSD.

Please budget extra time for parking or take transit. You may need to park off site or the Ops Centre potentially may not be easily accessible.

The effects to the travelling public could start as early as tomorrow with the Company potentially weeding out flights – especially overseas flights – and definitely by Friday evening local time which would be Saturday eastern time when the Lockout / Strike would be legal.
