# CUPE Air Canada Flight Attendants Strike / Lockout Update #2

We met with the Company this afternoon to discuss the implications of Picket Lines in around the workplace. We asked if they would provide safe passage from alternate parking locations as in previous work stoppages. The Company advised they would not because they were confident all employees would have free passage to the Ops Centre (Hangar) parking lot(s).

They have assured me that they will treat Saturday like a "Snow Day" so we will not be penalized for being late. If we are held up finding a safe route to the punch clock, we will have the ability to "flex" if we wish.

We will not cross a picket line but we can find alternate "safe" routes to the punch clock using any of the three levels in either terminal. (We have been told the Skytrain level will not be affected but things are always in flux.) If you do encounter a picket line please say, "Hi," show them solidarity and support, for in a few months, the situation will be reversed. Do not cross but find another way.

If you are delayed or feel unsafe finding an alternate route, call your CEM to explain the situation. Follow their instructions and document the time, location and details. Email me with those details should we need to follow up later. Remember, the **Company must ensure safe passage into the workplace.**
